**WHO & WHAT:** Gen. Raymond T. Odierno, 38<sup>th</sup> Chief of Staff United States Army, will host a retirement and special review in honor of the 32<sup>nd</sup> Vice Chief of Staff United States Army, Gen. Peter W. Chiarelli.

**WHEN:** Tuesday, January 31 at 10 a.m.

**WHERE:** Summerall Field, Joint Base Myer-Henderson Hall, Va. In the event of inclement weather, the ceremony will be conducted inside Joint Base Myer-Henderson Hall's Conmy Hall.

### REGISTRATION:

- Media interested in covering this ceremony must register by **noon, Monday, January 30** to be placed on the credentialed list; send an email to [mediadesk@jfhqncr.northcom.mil](mailto:mediadesk@jfhqncr.northcom.mil) with the following information: **your name, media organization, contact phone number, and vehicle info (tags, year, make, and model).**
- Registered media should report to Joint Base Myer-Henderson Hall's main entrance (Hatfield Gate) between **8 a.m. and 9:15 a.m.** Be advised that heightened security measures require all vehicles to be searched upon entry to the installation. Delays may be encountered, so be sure to add at least 20 minutes to your travel time.
- Media will be escorted to a designated parking area and shuttled to/from Summerall Field.

**DIRECTIONS TO JOINT BASE MYER-HENDERSON HALL:** Joint Base Myer-Henderson Hall, Va., is located across the Potomac River from Washington, D.C., adjacent to Arlington National Cemetery. Hatfield Gate is located on Washington Blvd. at South 2<sup>nd</sup> Street. Take 395 out of the city and into Virginia. Pass the Pentagon and take Exit 8A for Washington Blvd. Proceed on Washington Blvd. and take exit marked "Fort Myer Only" on the right.
