Prime Minister of Georgia to Lay Wreath at Tomb of the Unknowns

WHO & WHAT: His Excellency Irakli Garibashvili, the Prime Minister of Georgia, and Maj. Gen. Jeffrey S. Buchanan, commanding general, U.S. Army Military District of Washington, will lay a wreath at the Tomb of the Unknown Soldier in honor of the prime minister's visit to the United States.

WHEN: Tuesday, February 25 at 10 a.m.

WHERE: Tomb of the Unknown Soldier, Arlington National Cemetery, Arlington, Va.

REGISTRATION:

Media interested in covering this event must register by **9 a.m., Monday, February 24**. To be placed on the credentialed list, send an email to usarmy.mcnair.mdw.mbx.mediadesk-omb@mail.mil with the following information: **your full name, date of birth, place of birth, social security number, media organization, assignment, contact phone number, email address, and vehicle info (tags, year, make, and model)**.

The U.S. Army Military District of Washington Public Affairs Office will contact media outlets with their credential status no later than **noon, Monday, February 24**.

EDITOR'S NOTE:

Due to construction near the Tomb of the Unknown Soldier, satellite pre-cabling is not possible at this time. Media wishing to carry the event live are permitted to bring mobile broadcasting equipment capable of live feeds. Please provide this information when registering.

MEDIA REPORT TIME:

ALL registered media must report to Memorial Avenue between 9 and 9:15 a.m. to be escorted to the ceremony. Upon arrival to Arlington National Cemetery, members of the press are requested to provide **name and media organization** to the security guard at the main gate on Memorial Avenue. Media will be directed to a staging location. A public affairs representative will escort media into and out of the cemetery. Media must provide their own transportation.
