ARRAIGNMENT TO BE HELD AT FORT BELVOIR

WHAT: Lt. Col. Terrence Lakin is being arraigned on three counts of disobeying a lawful order (Article 92), one count of missing movement (Article 87), and dereliction of duty. These charges are for violations of the UCMJ which are alleged to have taken place on or about March 31, 2010 and April 12, 2010.

WHEN: Friday, Aug. 6, 2010, 11 a.m.

WHERE: Fort Belvoir, Va.

Registration Deadline: 4 p.m. Thursday, Aug. 5, 2010

Initial Media Briefing: Friday, Aug. 6, 10 a.m. (upon arrival)

Location: Tulley Gate, Fort Belvoir

Registration: Seats in the courtroom are limited to 10 seats and registration will be taken on a first-come, first-served basis. Print and broadcast media are encouraged to pool in order to share information. Registration is by e-mail to mediadesk@jfhqncr.northcom.mil.

Report Time: Confirmed registered media covering the arraignment should report to Fort Belvoir's Tully Gate **no later than 9:45 a.m.**

ACCESS AND DIRECTIONS TO FORT BELVOIR VISITOR GATE

1. Driving Directions

- **Coming from South:** Take I-95 North towards Washington. Take exit 161 to merge onto US-1 N/Richmond Hwy toward Fort Belvoir/Mt Vernon. You will travel five miles to Fort Belvoir. Continue through the light at the Fairfax County Parkway (VA 7100). At the next stop light, on the right side you will see the entrance for Tulley Gate, turn right.
- **Coming from North:** Take I-95 South towards Richmond. Take exit 166 A for Fairfax Parkway/Backlick Road (7100). Take the Fairfax County Parkway to its end at U.S. Rt. 1 (Richmond Highway) and then turn left. At the first light, on the right, is the entrance for Tulley Gate on to Fort Belvoir.

2. Confirmed media personnel should meet a Public Affairs escort at Tulley Gate no later than 9:45 a.m. the day of the arraignment. A security sweep of equipment will take place at the reserved media parking area. **The media group will depart Tulley Gate at 10 a.m. and be escorted by public affairs to the courtroom. Media that does not arrive on time for the escort will be unable to attend the arraignment.** You will be required to wear your outlet's media credential at all times, either around the neck or pinned to clothing.

3. No cameras, PDA's, cell phones or recording devices will be allowed inside the courtroom during the arraignment. Media may take photographs and/or video in a designated area on the installation prior to and after the arraignment. No interviews will be conducted on the installation.

4. Members of the general public who would like to attend the arraignment may enter Fort Belvoir through Tulley gate with a valid form of state or federal issued identification. Parking is available on the east side of the Staff Judge Advocate building. Limited seating is available on a first come, first served basis in the courtroom gallery. Protesting is not authorized on military installations.
