Romanian army chief of staff to lay wreath at Tomb of the Unknown Soldier

WHO & WHAT: Lt. Gen. Dumitru Scarlat, chief of staff, Romanian Land Forces, will participate in an Army Full Honor Arrival ceremony and will lay a wreath at the Tomb of the Unknown Soldier as part of his official visit to the United States, Tuesday, Feb. 7.
