Japanese prime minister to lay wreath at Tomb of the Unknown Soldier

WHO & WHAT: His Excellency Shinzo Abe, Prime Minister of Japan, will lay a wreath at the Tomb of the Unknown Soldier as part of his official visit to the United States, Friday, Feb. 10.
