Japan's Chief of Staff to lay wreath at Tomb of the Unknown Soldier

WHO & WHAT: Gen. Koji Yamazaki, chief of staff, Japan Ground Self-Defense Force, will participate in an Army Full Honor Arrival ceremony and will lay a wreath at the Tomb of the Unknown Soldier during an Army Full Honor Wreath-laying Ceremony Tuesday, July 10.

Gen. Mark A. Milley, chief of staff, the U.S. Army, will host the arrival ceremony and Maj. Gen. Michael L. Howard, commanding general, Joint Force Headquarters – National Capital Region and U.S. Army Military District of Washington will host the wreath-laying ceremony.
