Media Coverage of motions hearing United States vs. Capt. Scott Hockenberry

WHAT: The military judge has scheduled a 39(a) motions hearing, in the case of United States vs. Capt. Scott Hockenberry, a Soldier charged with violating Article 120, Uniform Code of Military Justice (UCMJ), for the crime of sexual assault, and Article 128, UCMJ, for the crime of assault consummated by a battery.

Hockenberry is charged with three specifications of sexual assault, and three specifications of assault consummated by a battery, for conduct that allegedly occurred in 2016.

WHEN: Monday, July 23 at 9 a.m.

WHERE: Hill Hall, Building 257
Fort Belvoir, Virginia

REGISTRATION: Seats in the courtroom are limited to 10. Registration will be taken on a first-come, first-served basis. Print and broadcast media are encouraged to pool. Accredited media organizations interested in covering the hearing must register for credentials no later than **3 p.m., Thursday, July 19**.
