32nd Annual Army Ten-Miler Online Transfer Program Is Open

Second chance for runners to get into the ATM

Washington – The 32nd edition of the Army Ten-Miler sold out leaving many runners still looking for registration. To assist those runners, the Army Ten-Miler offers a unique opportunity for registered runners to officially transfer their entry to a potential runner.

The ATM Transfer Program is available online at www.armytenmiler.com through Aug. 19.

To initiate an official ATM transfer, those currently registered for the 2016 Army Ten-Miler must complete the online form available on the <u>ATM Online Transfer Program</u> page of the website. ATM runners will follow the instructions provided and include the new runner's email. The original runner will receive an email confirming the transfer request has been received, while the new runner will be sent an email inviting them to register for the 32nd ATM. All transfer requests must be submitted online. Each new runner will pay a \$25 fee to finalize the official transfer and must register for the 32nd ATM within 72 hours of completing the transfer.

When transferring an entry, ATM runners can request a refund for the initial registration or can donate the registration to a new runner. All monetary transactions will be handled online through a secure site. Runners interested in transferring their entry can locate potential runners through the <u>ATM Facebook page</u> and <u>ATM Online Transfer Boards</u>.

Editor's Note: The Army Ten-Miler is scheduled for Sunday, Oct. 9, in the nation's capital. Hosted by the U.S. Army Military District of Washington, ATM is the third largest 10-mile race in the world and attracts 35,000 military and civilian runners from around the globe.
