33rd Annual Army Ten-Miler Rolling Road Closures

WASHINGTON – More than 35,000 military and civilian runners are expected to attend the 33rd Annual Army Ten-Miler Sunday, Oct. 8. The race starts and finishes at the Pentagon and the route passes through parts of Arlington, Virginia, and Washington, D.C.

The following roads will be affected:

Route 110 (all lanes) will be closed from 5:30 a.m. to 1:30 p.m.

Beginning at 7:30 a.m., the following roads will close and re-open on a rolling schedule:

- Arlington Memorial Bridge
- Constitution Avenue, NW between 23rd Street and 18th Street
- Virginia Avenue (all lanes)
- Rock Creek Parkway south of Virginia Avenue, NW
- Independence Avenue, SW
- 7th and 9th Streets, SW between Independence Avenue and C Street
- 4th Street, along Jefferson Drive, SW
- 14th Street, south I-395 HOV (northbound)
- I-395 HOV Lane (northbound) to the Eads Street ramp
- Long Bridge Drive

The Army Ten-Miler is the third largest 10-mile race in the world and attracts 35,000 military and civilian runners from around the world annually. The race course begins and ends at the Pentagon and runs through the Nation's Capital passing national treasures such as the Lincoln Memorial, Korean War Memorial, Martin Luther King, Jr. Memorial and the Washington Monument.

EDITORS NOTES: Race weekend activities include the ATM Expo at the D.C. Armory, live music, youth activities, and the popular HOOAH Tent Zone. The expo is open to the general public Friday, Oct. 6 and Saturday, Oct. 7, from 10 a.m. to 6 p.m.

Race day features the U.S. Army Golden Knights Parachute Team, Youth Run, a post-race party featuring live-bands, entertainment, HOOAH Tents, and a Youth Activity Zone complete with a rock wall, the Boot Camp Challenge, ATM Youth Zone mascot, Champ the Cheetah and much more.
