2018 Army Ten-Miler Media Credentialing Information

WHAT: 34th Annual Army Ten-Miler

WHEN: Sunday, Oct. 7 at 8 a.m.

WHERE: Starts and ends at the Pentagon and travels through the heart of Washington, D.C.

REGISTRATION: Media interested in covering the Army Ten-Miler must register for credentials no later than **3 p.m.**, **Tuesday**, **Oct. 3**. To be placed on the registration list, send an email to usarmy.mcnair.mdw.mbx.atm-media@mail.mil with the following information: **your full name**, **media organization**, **assignment**, **contact phone number**, **email address**, **driver's license number and state of issuance**, **and vehicle info (tags**, **year**, **make**, **and model)**.

MEDIA SAT TRUCK PARKING: There is very limited space available for media satellite truck parking at the start line area. Parking access will be provided on a first-come, first-served basis. Contact the U.S. Army Military District of Washington Public Affairs Office points of contact, Shaunteh Kelly and Lauren Poindexter, to secure parking.

EDITOR'S NOTES/MEDIA ACCESS INFORMATION:

- All media must register with the U.S. Army Military District of Washington Public Affairs Office if they
 desire access to the 33rd annual Army Ten-Miler, its participants, runners and associated events (Race
 Expo, Clinics, Awards Ceremony, Youth Activity Zone and Runs).
- Media interested in covering the event live are permitted to bring mobile broadcasting equipment capable of live feeds. Please provide this information when registering.
- The U.S. Army Military District of Washington Public Affairs Office will contact media outlets with their credential status **no later than 4 p.m., Wednesday, Oct. 3**.
- All media are encouraged to pick-up credential packets **PRIOR** to race day, **Sunday**, **Oct. 7**. Packets will include credentials, fact sheets, pocket guides, and runners' biographies.
- If credentials are not received prior to race day, you may experience delays while awaiting final access authorization at the entrance checkpoint. Media must be credentialed before gaining entry to the start line.
