Interagency Emergency Management Exercise

Capital Shield 14 is an interagency emergency management exercise conducted by the JFHQ-NCR/MDW to validate its capability to provide Defense Support of Civil Authorities (DSCA) while working with and among subordinate units, service components, and local and Federal inter-agency mission partners. Some specific training objectives for this exercise are as follows: 1) Execute Command & Control with Subordinate Units, Service Components, NCR Installations, National Guard, JTF CAPMED and Inter-agency (IA) mission partners, 2) Further develop and refine interagency interoperability, coordination, and common situational awareness within the NCR, and 3) Conduct Joint Reception, Staging, Onward Movement and Integration procedures with Subordinate units, Service Components, and NCR Installations.

The Joint Force Headquarters-National Capital Region will host an Executive Observer's Day on Tuesday, October 1, 2013. Buses will depart Fort McNair at 12:30 p.m. and transport invited guests to different training sites and return to base at 4:00 PM.
