Prime Minister of Australia to lay wreath at Tomb of the Unknown Soldier

WHO & WHAT: His Excellency Scott Morrison, Prime Minister of the Commonwealth of Australia, will lay a wreath at the Tomb of the Unknown Soldier in an Armed Forces Full Honor Wreath Ceremony as part of his official visit to the United States.

Maj. Gen. Omar J. Jones IV, commanding general, Joint Force Headquarters – National Capital Region and U.S. Army Military District of Washington, will host the wreath-laying ceremony.
