Guam's Governor and Delegate to lay wreath at Tomb of the Unknown Soldier to commemorate 78th anniversary of the Liberation of Guam

WHO & WHAT: The Honorable Lourdes Aflague Leon Guerrero, Governor of Guam, and The Honorable Michael F.Q. San Nicolas, Delegate to the U.S. House of Representatives in the 116th U.S. Congress. Both officials will participate in an Army Full Honor Wreath Ceremony to commemorate the 78th Anniversary of the Liberation of Guam.

Maj. Gen. Allan M. Pepin, commanding general, Joint Task Force-National Capital Region and U.S. Army Military District of Washington, will host the wreath-laying ceremony.
